A BILL

To require the Secretary of Transportation and the Director of the National Weather Service to establish an interagency working group to develop best practices for roadway management, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Roadway Resiliency
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INTERAGENCY WORKING GROUP ON ROADWAY**
2 **MANAGEMENT IN INCLEMENT WEATHER.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
4 date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Transpor-
5 tation and the Director of the National Weather Service
6 shall establish an interagency working group to develop
7 best practices for roadway management in inclement
8 weather.

9 (b) SUBMISSION TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 180
10 days after the date on which the best practices required
11 under subsection (a) are established, the Secretary and the
12 Director shall submit such best practices to the Committee
13 on Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of
14 Representatives and the Committee on Commerce,
15 Science, and Transportation of the Senate.

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
