Mr. VAN DREW (for himself and Mr. COURTNEY) introduced the following bill;
which was referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To establish the Agent Orange Veterans Service Medal.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Agent Orange Service
5 Medal Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE AGENT ORANGE VET-**
7 **ERANS SERVICE MEDAL.**

8 (a) SERVICE MEDAL REQUIRED.—The Secretary of
9 Defense shall design and produce a commemorative mili-
10 tary service medal, to be known as the “Agent Orange
11 Veterans Service Medal”, to honor a veteran who—

1 (1) receives compensation under section 1116,
2 1116A, or 1116B of title 38, United States Code; or

3 (2) is a Vietnam-era herbicide-exposed veteran,
4 as such term is defined in section 1710(e) of such
5 title.

6 (b) DISTRIBUTION OF MEDAL.—

7 (1) ISSUANCE TO CERTAIN VETERANS.—At the
8 request of an individual whom the Secretary of Vet-
9 erans Affairs certifies is a veteran described in sub-
10 section (a), the Secretary of Defense shall issue to
11 the veteran the Agent Orange Veterans Service
12 Medal.

13 (2) ISSUANCE TO NEXT-OF-KIN.—In the case of
14 a veteran described in subsection (a) who is de-
15 ceased, the Secretary of Defense may provide for
16 issuance of the Agent Orange Veterans Service
17 Medal to the next-of-kin of the veteran.

18 (3) APPLICATION.—The Secretary shall prepare
19 and disseminate as appropriate an application by
20 which veterans described in subsection (a) and their
21 next-of-kin may apply to receive the Agent Orange
22 Veterans Service Medal.
