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## A BILL

To amend title 31, United States Code, to require the President to consider the Government Accountability Office’s annual report on how to improve the efficiency and effectiveness of Government when preparing the President’s annual budget submission, and for other purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “Fighting Budget  
5        Waste Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. CONSIDERATION OF GAO REPORT WHEN PRE-**  
2 **PARING ANNUAL BUDGET SUBMISSION.**

3 Section 1105 of title 31, United States Code, is  
4 amended by adding at the end the following:

5 “(j)(1) When preparing any budget pursuant to sub-  
6 section (a) for a fiscal year, the President and the Director  
7 of the Office of Management and Budget shall consider  
8 information and recommendations contained in the most  
9 recently published Government Accountability Office re-  
10 port titled ‘Additional Opportunities to Reduce Frag-  
11 mentation, Overlap, and Duplication and Achieve Billions  
12 of Dollars in Financial Benefits’ (or any successor report).

13 “(2) On the date such budget is submitted to Con-  
14 gress, the Director shall submit a report to Congress on  
15 the Office’s findings with respect to such information and  
16 recommendations.”.

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
