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## A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to allow the deduction of taxes and State-mandated surcharges included on gas or electric utility bills.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Taxes on Utility  
5 Bills Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DEDUCTION FOR TAXES AND STATE-MANDATED**  
2 **SURCHARGES INCLUDED ON GAS OR ELEC-**  
3 **TRIC UTILITY BILLS.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 164(a) of the Internal  
5 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by adding at the end  
6 the following new paragraph:

7 “(5) All taxes, and State-mandated surcharges,  
8 included on the taxpayer’s gas or electric utility  
9 bills.”.

10 (b) **CONFORMING AMENDMENT.**—Section 164(a) of  
11 such section is amended by inserting “(and State-man-  
12 dated surcharges described in paragraph (5))” after “the  
13 following taxes”.

14 (c) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by  
15 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after  
16 the date of the enactment of this Act.

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
