## A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act to repeal the authority to grant temporary protected status, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Territorial Protection  
5 and Sovereignty Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF TEMPORARY PROTECTED STATUS.**

7 (a) REPEAL.—Section 244 of the Immigration and  
8 Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1254a) is repealed.

9 (b) EXISTING GRANTS.—

1           (1) IN GENERAL.—Any grant of temporary pro-  
2           tected status that is in effect on the date of enact-  
3           ment of this Act shall terminate on the date of en-  
4           actment of this Act.

5           (2) DEPARTURE.—An alien whose temporary  
6           protected status is terminated under paragraph (1)  
7           shall depart the United States not later than 60  
8           days after the date of enactment of this Act, and  
9           shall cease to be considered lawfully present in the  
10          United States on and after the date that is 60 days  
11          after the date of enactment of this Act.
