A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to improve access to skilled nursing facilities for primary immunodeficiency patients.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “PI Post Acute Access
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. IMPROVING ACCESS TO SKILLED NURSING FACIL-**
2 **ITY SERVICES FOR PRIMARY IMMUNO-**
3 **DEFICIENCY PATIENTS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1888(e)(2)(A)(iii) of the
5 Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395yy(e)(2)(A)(iii)) is
6 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
7 clause:

8 “(VII) Intravenous immune glob-
9 ulin indicated for the treatment of
10 primary immune deficiency disease
11 (identified as of January 1, 2026, by
12 HCPCS codes J1561, J1569, J1576,
13 J1568, J1459, J1554, J1557, J1566,
14 and as subsequently modified by the
15 Secretary) and items and services re-
16 lated to the furnishing of such glob-
17 ulin.”.

18 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
19 subsection (a) shall apply to items and services furnished
20 on or after October 1, 2026.

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
