A BILL

To repeal the wage requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Davis-Bacon Repeal
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF DAVIS-BACON WAGE REQUIREMENTS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter IV of chapter 31 of
8 title 40, United States Code, is repealed.

9 (b) REFERENCE.—Any reference in any law to a re-
10 quirement under subchapter IV of chapter 31 of title 40,
11 United States Code, shall be null and void.

1 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE AND LIMITATION.**

2 Section 2, and the amendment made by such section,
3 shall take effect 30 days after the date of enactment of
4 this Act but shall not affect any contract that is—

5 (1) in existence on the date that is 30 days
6 after such date of enactment; or

7 (2) made pursuant to an invitation for bids out-
8 standing on the date that is 30 days after such date
9 of enactment.
