## A BILL

To require GAO to conduct annual assessments to determine the extent to which TSAs passenger security screening practices comply with TSA non-discrimination policies to identify any needed actions to improve compliance, and for other purposes.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2        *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3        **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Passengers  
5        from Discrimination Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. GAO ASSESSMENTS OF TSA COMPLIANCE WITH**  
2 **NON-DISCRIMINATION POLICIES DURING**  
3 **PASSENGER SECURITY SCREENINGS.**

4 Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact-  
5 ment of this Act and annually thereafter, the Comptroller  
6 General of the United States shall submit to the Com-  
7 mittee on Homeland Security of the House of Representa-  
8 tives and the Committee on Commerce, Science, and  
9 Transportation an assessment of the extent to which pas-  
10 senger security screening practices of the Transportation  
11 Security Administration comply with non-discrimination  
12 policies of the Administration in order to identify any  
13 needed actions to improve such compliance.
