A BILL

To provide that Executive Order 14399 shall have no force or effect, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Vote by Mail Protec-
5 tion Act of 2026”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXECUTIVE ORDER 14399.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Executive Order 14399 (91 Fed.
8 Reg. 17125; relating to ensuring citizenship verification

1 and integrity in Federal elections) shall have no force or
2 effect, and any contract or arrangement entered into by
3 an agency to carry out activities pursuant to such Execu-
4 tive order shall be abrogated.

5 (b) PROHIBITION.—None of the funds made available
6 for the salaries and expenses of an agency may be used
7 to carry out activities pursuant to such Executive order.
