A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to transmit a veteran's history of opioid prescriptions to a Community Care health care provider.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TRANSMISSION OF OPIOID PRESCRIPTION HIS-**
4 **TORY TO COMMUNITY CARE PROVIDER.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1703C of title 38, United
6 States Code, is amended, in subsection (a), by adding at
7 the end the following new paragraph:

1 “(8) The standards established under this subsection
2 shall require the Secretary to transmit a history of opioid
3 prescriptions contained in records of the Department re-
4 garding a covered veteran—

5 “(A) to a non-Department health care provider
6 through whom the Secretary furnishes health care,
7 pursuant to section 1703 of this title, to such cov-
8 ered veteran; and

9 “(B) through a Third Party Administrator.”.

10 (b) DEFINITIONS.—Such section is further amended,
11 in subsection (c), by adding at the end the following new
12 paragraphs:

13 “(3) The term ‘Third Party Administrator’ has
14 the meaning given such term in section 1703B of
15 this title.”.

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
