## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to expand the authority of the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to provide or assist in providing a vehicle adapted for operation by a disabled individual to certain eligible persons, by paying expenses associated with the delivery of such vehicle, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Deliver for Veterans  
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AUTHORITY OF THE SECRETARY OF VETERANS AF-**  
2 **FAIRS TO PAY COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE**  
3 **DELIVERY OF AN ADAPTIVE VEHICLE TO AN**  
4 **ELIGIBLE PERSON.**

5 Section 3902(a) of title 38, United States Code, is  
6 amended by striking “by paying the total purchase price  
7 of the automobile or other conveyance” and inserting “by  
8 paying the total purchase price of the automobile or other  
9 conveyance, and the total shipping price to deliver the  
10 automobile or other conveyance to the veteran”.
