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## A BILL

To require the Administrator of General Services to display or inscribe the national motto of the United States on all Federal buildings, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “In God We Trust Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DISPLAY OF NATIONAL MOTTO ON FEDERAL BUILD-**  
2 **INGS.**

3 (a) DEFINITION OF PUBLIC BUILDING.—In this sec-  
4 tion, the term “public building” has the meaning given  
5 the term in section 3301(a) of title 40, United States  
6 Code.

7 (b) REQUIREMENT.—Not later than 1 year after the  
8 date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator of Gen-  
9 eral Services shall inscribe or display in a place of promi-  
10 nence on every public building the national motto of the  
11 United States, as described in section 302 of title 36,  
12 United States Code.

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
