Mr. MCGUIRE (for himself, Mr. HUNT, and Mr. VAN EPPS) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend title 18, United States, to include property damage in acts that constitute domestic terrorism, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Accountability
5 for Felony Obstruction Act” or the “FAFO Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF PROPERTY DAMAGE IN DEFINITION**
7 **OF DOMESTIC TERRORISM.**

8 Section 2331(5)(A) of title 18, United States Code,
9 is amended to read as follows:

10 “(A) involve acts that—

1 “(i) are a violation of the criminal
2 laws of the United States or of any State,
3 and that are dangerous to human life or
4 are likely to cause significant damage to
5 property; and

6 “(ii) that obstruct or impede—

7 “(I) a law enforcement officer or
8 a first responder in carrying out their
9 duties; or

10 “(II) a person seeking medical
11 attention;”.

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
