3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Homeland Security
5 Capabilities Preservation Reporting Act of 2026”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORTS ON TRANSITION OF JURISDICTIONS NO**
2 **LONGER ELIGIBLE FOR URBAN AREA SECU-**
3 **RITY INITIATIVE FUNDING.**

4 Paragraph (1) of section 7102(b) of the James M.
5 Inhofe National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year
6 2023 (Public Law 117–263) is amended, in the matter
7 preceding subparagraph (A), by inserting “and every three
8 years thereafter” after “Not later than 18 months after
9 the date of the enactment of this Act”.
