A BILL

To redesignate a playground in the New River Gorge National Park and Preserve in the State of West Virginia as the “Hearts of Gold Playground: In Honor of West Virginia Children and Families Impacted by Childhood Cancer”.

1 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION OF THE “HEARTS OF GOLD**
2 **PLAYGROUND: IN HONOR OF WEST VIRGINIA**
3 **CHILDREN AND FAMILIES IMPACTED BY**
4 **CHILDHOOD CANCER” IN THE NEW RIVER**
5 **GORGE NATIONAL PARK AND PRESERVE,**
6 **WEST VIRGINIA.**

7 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The primary playground lo-
8 cated in the Grandview area south of the amphitheater
9 at New River Gorge National Park and Preserve in the
10 State of West Virginia shall be known and designated as
11 the “Hearts of Gold Playground: In Honor of West Vir-
12 ginia Children and Families Impacted by Childhood Can-
13 cer”.

14 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
15 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
16 States to the playground referred to in subsection (a) shall
17 be deemed to be a reference to the “Hearts of Gold Play-
18 ground: In Honor of West Virginia Children and Families
19 Impacted by Childhood Cancer”.
