A BILL

To amend title 1, United States Code, to expand the scope of documents the Secretary of State is required to transmit to the Congress, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF CASE-ZABLOCKI ACT TRANS-**
4 **PARENCY REQUIREMENTS.**

5 Section 112b(k)(5) of title 1, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) in subparagraph (A), by striking “; and” at
8 the end and inserting a semicolon;

1 (2) in subparagraph (B), by striking the period
2 at the end and inserting “; and”; and

3 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
4 paragraph:

5 “(C) includes an agreement otherwise de-
6 scribed in subparagraph (A), whether written or
7 oral, under which a foreign country accepts into
8 the territory of the country any number of for-
9 eign nationals who are not nationals of that
10 country and are subject to final orders of re-
11 moval from the United States, and such agree-
12 ment, to the extent oral, shall be reduced to
13 writing for purposes of compliance with the re-
14 quirements of this section.”.

15 **SEC. 2. DEADLINE FOR POST-AUDIT REPORT SUBMISSION**

16 **BY THE COMPTROLLER GENERAL.**

17 Section 112b(h)(3) of title 1, United States Code, is
18 amended by striking “The Comptroller General” and in-
19 serting “Not later than 30 days after concluding an audit
20 required by paragraph (1), the Comptroller General”.

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
