A BILL

To prohibit the imposition of the death penalty for any violation of Federal law, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Death Penalty
5 Prohibition Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON IMPOSITION OF DEATH SEN-**
2 **TENCE.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
4 sion of law, no person may be sentenced to death or put
5 to death on or after the date of enactment of this Act
6 for any violation of Federal law.

7 (b) PERSONS SENTENCED BEFORE DATE OF ENACT-
8 MENT.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any
9 person sentenced to death before the date of enactment
10 of this Act for any violation of Federal law shall be resen-
11 tenced.

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
