## A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development from considering disparate impact in carrying out any actions of the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Housing Regulatory  
5 Clarity Act of 2026”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON CONSIDERATION OF DISPARATE**  
2 **IMPACT.**

3 The Secretary of Housing and Urban Development  
4 may not consider disparate impact in carrying out any ac-  
5 tions of the Department of Housing and Urban Develop-  
6 ment.
