## A BILL

To expand eligibility for special overtime pay to U.S. Border  
Patrol agents classified above grade GS–12.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Border Patrol Super-  
5 visors Retention Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF HIGHER RATES OF REGU-**  
2 **LARLY SCHEDULED OVERTIME PAY FOR CER-**  
3 **TAIN U.S. BORDER PATROL AGENTS.**

4 Section 5550(h) of title 5, United States Code, is  
5 amended—

6 (1) in the subsection heading, by striking “GS-  
7 12 BORDER PATROL AGENTS” and inserting “BOR-  
8 DER PATROL AGENTS CLASSIFIED FROM GRADE  
9 GS-12 THROUGH GS-15”; and

10 (2) in paragraph (1), by striking “a position at  
11 grade GS-12” and inserting “a position from grade  
12 GS-12 through GS-15”.
