A BILL

To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to require States to report on anti-fraud measures relating to home and community-based services furnished under the Medicaid program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “HCBS Anti-Fraud Re-
5 porting Act of 2026”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIRING STATES TO REPORT ON ANTI-FRAUD**
2 **MEASURES RELATING TO HOME AND COMMU-**
3 **NITY-BASED SERVICES FURNISHED UNDER**
4 **THE MEDICAID PROGRAM.**

5 Section 1915(c)(2) of the Social Security Act (42
6 U.S.C. 1396n(c)(2)) is amended—

7 (1) in subparagraph (D), by striking “and” at
8 the end;

9 (2) in subparagraph (E), by striking the period
10 and inserting “; and”; and

11 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
12 paragraph:

13 “(F) with respect to 2026 and each subsequent
14 year, the State will report to the Secretary on—

15 “(i) any waste, fraud, or abuse detected by
16 the State relating to services furnished under
17 such waiver; and

18 “(ii) efforts taken by the State to prevent
19 such waste, fraud, and abuse.”.

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
