A BILL

To amend section 313 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 to designate provisions resulting in the sale, disposal, or transfer of Federal lands as extraneous under the Byrd Rule.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Public Lands Integrity
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROVISIONS RESULTING IN THE SALE, DISPOSAL,**
2 **OR TRANSFER OF FEDERAL LANDS DES-**
3 **IGNATED AS EXTRANEEOUS UNDER THE BYRD**
4 **RULE.**

5 Section 313(b)(1) of the Congressional Budget Act
6 of 1974 (2 U.S.C. 644(b)(1)) is amended—

7 (1) by striking “and (F)” and inserting “(F)”;
8 and

9 (2) by inserting “; and (G) a provision that re-
10 sults in the sale, disposal, or transfer of Federal
11 lands shall be considered extraneous” before the pe-
12 riod at the end.

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
