To amend title 5, United States Code, to provide that judicial review under the Administrative Procedure Act does not include any evidence that the court determines is not the product of reliable scientific principles and methods.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EVIDENCE DERIVED FROM RELIABLE SCI-**
4 **ENTIFIC PRINCIPLES AND METHODS.**

5 Section 706(2) of title 5, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) in subparagraph (E) by striking “or” at the
8 end;

1 (2) in subparagraph (F) by striking the period
2 at the end and inserting “; or”; and

3 (3) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(G) supported by evidence that the court
5 determines is not the product of reliable sci-
6 entific principles and methods, or that does not
7 reflect a reliable application of those principles
8 and methods.”.

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
