Mr. MCDOWELL (for himself, Mr. EDWARDS, and Mr. MOORE of North Carolina) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform

A BILL

To amend title VI of the Social Security Act to extend that date on which certain funds related to broadband infrastructure projects may be expended.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Broadband Infrastruc-
5 ture Extension Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF DEADLINES FOR CERTAIN FISCAL**
2 **RECOVERY AND CRITICAL CAPITAL**
3 **PROJECTS FUNDS.**

4 (a) STATE FISCAL RECOVERY FUND.—Section
5 602(e)(5)(E) of the Social Security Act is amended by
6 adding at the end the following: “Notwithstanding the pre-
7 vious sentence, such funds provided for projects related
8 to broadband infrastructure may be expended through
9 September 30, 2027.”.

10 (b) LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUND.—Section
11 603(e)(6)(D) of the Social Security Act is amended by
12 adding at the end the following: “Notwithstanding the pre-
13 vious sentence, such funds provided for projects related
14 to broadband infrastructure may be expended through
15 September 30, 2027.”.

16 (c) CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND.—Section 604 of the
17 Social Security Act is amended by—

18 (1) redesignating subsection (d) as subsection
19 (e); and

20 (2) by inserting after subsection (c) the fol-
21 lowing:

22 “(d) AVAILABILITY.—Funds provided under a pay-
23 ment made under this section for a project related to
24 broadband infrastructure may be expended prior to Janu-
25 ary 1, 2028.”.
