A BILL

To require the Secretary of Transportation to issue regulations to prohibit certain cell phone voice communications on aircraft in scheduled passenger interstate or intrastate air transportation.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Quiet Skies Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN CELL PHONE VOICE**
6 **COMMUNICATIONS.**

7 Not later than 180 days after the date of enactment
8 of this Act, the Secretary of Transportation shall issue a

1 final rule with respect to the regulations required to be
2 issued under section 41725 of title 49, United States
3 Code.
