## RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to establish a Permanent Select Committee on Aging.

1       *Resolved*, That rule X of the Rules of the House of  
2 Representatives is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
3 lowing new clause:

4       **“Permanent Select Committee on Aging**

5       “12. There is established a Permanent Select Com-  
6 mittee on Aging which shall not have legislative jurisdic-  
7 tion but which shall have jurisdiction—

8               “(1) to conduct a continuing comprehensive  
9 study and review of the problems of the older Amer-  
10 ican, including but not limited to income mainte-

1 nance, poverty, housing, health (including medical  
2 research), welfare, employment, education, recre-  
3 ation, and long-term care;

4 “(2) to study the use of all practicable means  
5 and methods of encouraging the development of pub-  
6 lic and private programs and policies which will as-  
7 sist the older American in taking a full part in na-  
8 tional life and which will encourage the utilization of  
9 the knowledge, skills, special aptitudes, and abilities  
10 of older Americans to contribute to a better quality  
11 of life for all Americans;

12 “(3) to develop policies that would encourage  
13 the coordination of both governmental and private  
14 programs designed to deal with problems of aging;  
15 and

16 “(4) to review any recommendations made by  
17 the President or by the White House Conference on  
18 aging relation to programs or policies affecting older  
19 Americans.”.
