RESOLUTION

Relating to questions of privilege in the House of Representatives during the One Hundred Nineteenth Congress.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. QUESTIONS OF PRIVILEGE IN THE HOUSE OF**
3 **REPRESENTATIVES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—During the remainder of the One
5 Hundred Nineteenth Congress in the House of Represent-
6 atives, notwithstanding clause 2(a)(1) of rule IX of the
7 Rules of the House, with respect to a resolution described
8 in subsection (c), the Chair may not entertain—

1 (1) any such resolution offered by the Majority
2 Leader or the Minority Leader unless the resolution
3 has accumulated one-fifth of the total membership of
4 the House as cosponsors at the time it is offered; or

5 (2) an announcement by a Member, Delegate,
6 or Resident Commissioner of an intention to offer
7 any such resolution unless the resolution has main-
8 tained at least one-fifth of the total membership of
9 the House as cosponsors for at least one legislative
10 day after its introduction.

11 (b) ORAL ANNOUNCEMENT.—Oral announcement of
12 the form of a resolution referred to in subsection (a) shall
13 be considered as dispensed with.

14 (c) RESOLUTION DESCRIBED.—A resolution de-
15 scribed in this subsection is a resolution offered from the
16 floor of the House of Representatives as a question of the
17 privileges of the House addressing the conduct of any
18 Member, Delegate, or Resident Commissioner, but does
19 not include a resolution described in clause 2(a)(3) of rule
20 IX of the Rules of the House.

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
