Whereas a “National Small Business Week” has been declared by every President since 1963;

Whereas there are more than 36,000,000 small businesses in the United States that support more than 62,000,000 jobs;

Whereas small businesses play an integral role in building the economy of the United States; and

Whereas May 3, 2026, through May 9, 2026, would be an appropriate week to celebrate “National Small Business Week”: Now, therefore, be it

1       *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives—

2               (1) honors and celebrates the entrepreneurial  
3       spirit and contributions of small businesses in every  
4       community in the United States;

5               (2) applauds the efforts and achievements of  
6       the owners of small businesses and their employees  
7       in every community in the United States; and

8               (3) supports the designation of “National Small  
9       Business Week”.
