Mr. MCGOVERN submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 185) to advance responsible policies.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in
3 the House of the bill (H.R. 185) to advance responsible
4 policies. All points of order against consideration of the
5 bill are waived. An amendment in the nature of a sub-
6 stitute received for printing in the portion of the Congres-
7 sional Record designated for that purpose in clause 8 of
8 rule XVIII dated at least one day before the day of consid-
9 eration of H.R. 185, if submitted by the ranking minority
10 member of the Committee on Rules, shall be considered

1 as adopted. If more than one such amendment is sub-
2 mitted, then only the last amendment submitted shall be
3 considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be con-
4 sidered as read. All points of order against provisions in
5 the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question
6 shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended,
7 and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage
8 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate
9 equally divided and controlled by the majority leader and
10 minority leader or their respective designees; and (2) one
11 motion to recommit.

12 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX and clause 8 of rule
13 XX shall not apply to the consideration of H.R. 185.

14 SEC. 3. The Clerk shall transmit to the Senate a mes-
15 sage that the House has passed H.R. 185 no later than
16 one week after passage.

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
