Mr. KEATING submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 7016) to prohibit action to or the use of Federal funds to invade NATO countries and territories, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in
3 the House of the bill (H.R. 7016) to prohibit action to
4 or the use of Federal funds to invade NATO countries
5 and territories, and for other purposes. All points of order
6 against consideration of the bill are waived. An amend-
7 ment in the nature of a substitute received for printing
8 in the portion of the Congressional Record designated for
9 that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII dated at least one

1 day before the day of consideration of H.R. 7016, if sub-
2 mitted by Representative Keating of Massachusetts, shall
3 be considered as adopted. If more than one such amend-
4 ment is submitted, then only the last amendment sub-
5 mitted shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as amend-
6 ed, shall be considered as read. All points of order against
7 provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The pre-
8 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill,
9 as amended, and on any further amendment thereto, to
10 final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
11 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair
12 and ranking minority member of the Committee on For-
13 eign Affairs or their respective designees; and (2) one mo-
14 tion to recommit.

15 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX and clause 8 of rule
16 XX shall not apply to the consideration of H.R. 7016.

17 SEC. 3. The Clerk shall transmit to the Senate a mes-
18 sage that the House has passed H.R. 7016 no later than
19 3 days after passage.
