Mr. CASTEN (for himself and Ms. STEVENS) submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1101) to prohibit unlawful access to the payment system of the Bureau of the Fiscal Service within the Department of the Treasury, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in
3 the House of the bill (H.R. 1101) to prohibit unlawful ac-
4 cess to the payment system of the Bureau of the Fiscal
5 Service within the Department of the Treasury, and for
6 other purposes. All points of order against consideration
7 of the bill are waived. The bill shall be considered as read.
8 All points of order against provisions in the bill are

1 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-
2 dered on the bill and on any amendment thereto to final
3 passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour
4 of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and
5 ranking minority member of the Committee on Financial
6 Services or their respective designees; and (2) one motion
7 to recommit.

8 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX and clause 8 of rule
9 XX shall not apply to the consideration of H.R. 1101.

10 SEC. 3. The Clerk shall transmit to the Senate a mes-
11 sage that the House has passed H.R. 1101 no later than
12 one week after passage.
