RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 91) relating to a national emergency by the President on April 2, 2025.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in
3 the House of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 91) relating
4 to a national emergency by the President on April 2, 2025.
5 All points of order against consideration of the joint reso-
6 lution are waived. The joint resolution shall be considered
7 as read. All points of order against provisions in the joint
8 resolution are waived. The previous question shall be con-
9 sidered as ordered on the joint resolution and on any
10 amendment thereto to final passage without intervening

1 motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and
2 controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of
3 the Committee on Foreign Affairs or their respective des-
4 ignees; and (2) one motion to recommit.

5 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX and clause 8 of rule
6 XX shall not apply to the consideration of H.J. Res. 91.

7 SEC. 3. The Clerk shall transmit to the Senate a mes-
8 sage that the House has passed H.J. Res. 91 no later than
9 one week after passage.

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
