# RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the joint resolution (H. J. Res. 12) proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to limit the number of terms that a Member of Congress may serve.

1       *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-  
2 olution, without intervention of any point of order, the  
3 House shall proceed to the consideration in the House of  
4 the joint resolution (H. J. Res. 12) proposing an amend-  
5 ment to the Constitution of the United States to limit the  
6 number of terms that a Member of Congress may serve.  
7 The resolution shall be considered as read. The previous  
8 question shall be considered as ordered on the resolution

1 to adoption without intervening motion or demand for di-  
2 vision of the question except one hour of debate equally  
3 divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority  
4 member of the Committee on the Judiciary or their respec-  
5 tive designees.

6 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX shall not apply to  
7 the consideration of H. J. Res. 12.
