Mrs. FLETCHER submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 999) to protect an individual's ability to access contraceptives and to engage in contraception and to protect a health care providers ability to provide contraceptives, contraception, and information related to contraception.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-
2 olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in
3 the House of the bill (H.R. 999) to protect an individual's
4 ability to access contraceptives and to engage in contra-
5 ception and to protect a health care providers ability to
6 provide contraceptives, contraception, and information re-
7 lated to contraception. All points of order against consid-

1 eration of the bill are waived. The bill shall be considered
2 as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill
3 are waived. The previous question shall be considered as
4 ordered on the bill and on any amendment thereto to final
5 passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour
6 of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and
7 ranking minority member of the Committee on Energy
8 and Commerce or their respective designees; and (2) one
9 motion to recommit.

10 SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX and clause 8 of rule
11 XX shall not apply to the consideration of H.R. 999.

12 SEC. 3. The Clerk shall transmit to the Senate a mes-
13 sage that the House has passed H.R. 999 no later than
14 one week after passage.

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
