Mr. MORELLE submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 6039) to advance commonsense priorities.

1       *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-  
2       olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in  
3       the House of the bill (H.R. 6039) to advance common-  
4       sense priorities. All points of order against consideration  
5       of the bill are waived. An amendment in the nature of  
6       a substitute received for printing in the portion of the  
7       Congressional Record designated for that purpose in  
8       clause 8 of rule XVIII dated at least one day before the  
9       day of consideration of H.R. 6039, if submitted by the  
10      ranking minority member of the Committee on House Ad-

1 ministration, shall be considered as adopted. If more than  
2 one such amendment is submitted, then only the last  
3 amendment submitted shall be considered as adopted. The  
4 bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. All points  
5 of order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are  
6 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-  
7 dered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amend-  
8 ment thereto, to final passage without intervening motion  
9 except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and con-  
10 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the  
11 Committee on House Administration or their respective  
12 designees; and (2) one motion to recommit.

13       SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX and clause 8 of rule  
14 XX shall not apply to the consideration of H.R. 6039.

15       SEC. 3. The Clerk shall transmit to the Senate a mes-  
16 sage that the House has passed H.R. 6039 no later than  
17 three calendar days after passage.
