Mr. SUOZZI submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the  
Committee on Rules

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## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 5827) to  
advance bipartisan, common sense solutions.

1       *Resolved*, That immediately upon adoption of this res-  
2       olution, the House shall proceed to the consideration in  
3       the House of the bill (H.R. 5827) to advance bipartisan,  
4       common sense solutions. All points of order against con-  
5       sideration of the bill are waived. An amendment in the  
6       nature of a substitute received for printing in the portion  
7       of the Congressional Record designated for that purpose  
8       in clause 8 of rule XVIII dated at least one day before  
9       the day of consideration of H.R. 5827, if submitted by  
10      Representative Suozzi of New York, shall be considered

1 as adopted. If more than one such amendment is sub-  
2 mitted, then only the last amendment submitted shall be  
3 considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be con-  
4 sidered as read. All points of order against provisions in  
5 the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question  
6 shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended,  
7 and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage  
8 without intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate  
9 equally divided and controlled by Representative Suozzi of  
10 New York and an opponent or their respective designees;  
11 and (2) one motion to recommit.

12       SEC. 2. Clause 1(c) of rule XIX and clause 8 of rule  
13 XX shall not apply to the consideration of H.R. 5827.

14       SEC. 3. The Clerk shall transmit to the Senate a mes-  
15 sage that the House has passed H.R. 5827 no later than  
16 one calendar day after passage.

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
