**A BILL**

To require the Federal Communications Commission to issue an order providing that a shark attack is an event for which a wireless emergency alert may be transmitted, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as “Lulu’s Law”.

3 **SEC. 2. WIRELESS EMERGENCY ALERTS.**

4       (a) **DEFINITION.**—In this section, the term “Alert  
5 Message” has the meaning given the term in section  
6 10.10(a) of title 47, Code of Federal Regulations, or any  
7 successor regulation.

8       (b) **REQUIREMENT.**—Not later than 180 days after  
9 the date of enactment of this Act, the Federal Commu-  
10 nications Commission shall issue an order to provide that  
11 a shark attack is an event for which an Alert Message  
12 may be transmitted.
