A BILL

To repeal the Corporate Transparency Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Repealing Big Brother
5 Overreach Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Corporate Transparency Act
8 (title LXIV of division F of the William M. (Mac) Thorn-
9 berry National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year

1 2021 (Public Law 116–283; 134 Stat. 4604)) and the
 2 amendments made by that Act are repealed.

3 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

4 (1) Title 31, United States Code, is amended—

5 (A) in section 5321(a)—

6 (i) in paragraph (1), by striking “sec-
 7 tions 5314, 5315, and 5336” each place
 8 the term appears and inserting “sections
 9 5314 and 5315”; and

10 (ii) in paragraph (6), by striking “(ex-
 11 cept section 5336)” each place the term
 12 appears; and

13 (B) in section 5322, by striking “section
 14 5315, 5324, or 5336” each place the term ap-
 15 pears and inserting “section 5315 or 5324”.

16 (2) Title LXV of the Anti-Money Laundering
 17 Act of 2020 (division F of the of the William M.
 18 (Mac) Thornberry National Defense Authorization
 19 Act for Fiscal Year 2021 (Public Law 116–283; 134
 20 Stat. 4604)) is amended—

21 (A) by repealing section 6502 (134 Stat.
 22 4626); and

23 (B) in section 6509 (134 Stat. 4633)—
