## A BILL

To modify the requirements for transfers of United States defense articles and defense services among the Baltic states.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF REQUIREMENTS FOR**  
4 **TRANSFERS OF UNITED STATES DEFENSE AR-**  
5 **TICLES AND DEFENSE SERVICES AMONG BAL-**  
6 **TIC STATES.**

7       (a) IN GENERAL.—Any defense article or defense  
8 service provided by the United States to a Baltic state may  
9 be transferred by such Baltic state to any other Baltic

1 state without the approval of the United States as may  
2 be required under any other provision of law.

3 (b) COMMON COALITION KEY.—The Secretary of De-  
4 fense shall establish among the Baltic states a common  
5 coalition key within the Baltic states for the purpose of  
6 sharing ammunition for High Mobility Artillery Rocket  
7 Systems (HIMARS) among the Baltic states for training  
8 and operational purposes.

9 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

10 (1) BALTIC STATE.—The term “Baltic state”  
11 means the following:

12 (A) Estonia.

13 (B) Lithuania.

14 (C) Latvia.

15 (2) DEFENSE ARTICLE; DEFENSE SERVICE.—  
16 The terms “defense article” and “defense service”  
17 have the meanings given such terms in section 47 of  
18 the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2794).
