3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Restoring Fort Leon-
5 ard Wood Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. MILITARY CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS TO REPLACE**
2 **MILITARY FAMILY HOUSING UNITS AT FORT**
3 **LEONARD WOOD, MISSOURI.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Army shall
5 conduct a military construction project or military con-
6 struction projects to replace 1,142 units of military family
7 housing at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri.

8 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
9 authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary of the
10 Army \$700,000,000 to carry out subsection (a).

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
