A BILL

To repeal the Protecting Americans from Foreign Adversary
Controlled Applications Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Repeal the TikTok
5 Ban Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF PROTECTING AMERICANS FROM FOR-**
2 **EIGN ADVERSARY CONTROLLED APPLICA-**
3 **TIONS ACT.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Protecting Americans from
5 Foreign Adversary Controlled Applications Act (15 U.S.C.
6 9901 note; division H of Public Law 118–50) is repealed.

7 (b) RETROACTIVE EFFECT.—Any designation of a
8 website, desktop application, mobile application, or aug-
9 mented or immersive technology application as a foreign
10 adversary controlled application under the Protecting
11 Americans from Foreign Adversary Controlled Applica-
12 tions Act (15 U.S.C. 9901 note; division H of Public Law
13 118–50), whether under subparagraph (A) or (B) of sec-
14 tion 2(g)(3) of that Act, shall have no force or effect.

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
