A BILL

To exempt small business concerns from duties imposed pursuant to the national emergency declared on April 2, 2025, by the President.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 The Act may be cited as the “Small Business Libera-
5 tion Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. EXEMPTION FOR SMALL BUSINESS CONCERNS**
7 **FROM DUTIES IMPOSED PURSUANT TO NA-**
8 **TIONAL EMERGENCY DECLARATION.**

9 Duties imposed pursuant to Executive Order 14257
10 (90 Fed. Reg. 15041) shall not apply with respect to goods

1 imported by or for the use of small business concerns, as
2 defined in section 3 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
3 632).
