A BILL

To amend the William M. (Mac) Thornberry National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2021 to modify the provision relating to public reporting of Chinese military companies, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Safe Harbor for
5 the Enemy Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATION RELATING TO PUBLIC REPORTING**
2 **OF CHINESE MILITARY COMPANIES OPER-**
3 **ATING IN THE UNITED STATES.**

4 Section 1260H of the William M. (Mac) Thornberry
5 National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2021
6 (10 U.S.C. 113 note; Public Law 116–283) is amended—

7 (1) by redesignating subsections (f) and (g) as
8 subsections (g) and (h), respectively; and

9 (2) by inserting after subsection (e) the fol-
10 lowing new subsection (f):

11 “(f) **FINALITY OF DECISIONS.**—The decision of the
12 Secretary of Defense as to any question regarding the ad-
13 dition of an entity to the list required by subsection (b)(1)
14 shall be final and conclusive and may not be reviewed by
15 any other official or by any court, whether by an action
16 in the nature of mandamus or otherwise.”.

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
