Mr. MCCORMICK (for himself and Mr. FETTERMAN) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

A BILL

To require the Secretary of Energy to relocate the Office of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management to Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Office of Fossil Energy
5 and Carbon Management Relocation Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. RELOCATION OF OFFICE OF FOSSIL ENERGY AND**
7 **CARBON MANAGEMENT.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 72 of
9 title 4, United States Code, not later than December 31,

1 2026, the Secretary of Energy shall relocate the Office
2 of Fossil Energy and Carbon Management (referred to in
3 this section as the “Office”) from Washington, DC, to
4 Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

5 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the reloca-
6 tion required under subsection (a) is completed, the Sec-
7 retary of Energy shall submit to Congress a report de-
8 scribing—

9 (1) any attrition of employees from the Office
10 during and after that relocation;

11 (2) the extent to which that attrition is attrib-
12 utable to that relocation;

13 (3) how the Secretary of Energy will address
14 that attrition; and

15 (4) how that relocation affected the ability of
16 employees of the Office to negotiate through rep-
17 resentatives regarding conditions of employment.

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
