A BILL

To reserve to Congress the authority to establish or extend a national monument.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ending Presidential
5 Overreach on Public Lands Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. NATIONAL MONUMENTS.**

7 Section 320301 of title 54, United States Code (com-
8 monly referred to as the “Antiquities Act”), is amended
9 to read as follows:

1 **“§ 320301. National monuments**

2 “‘The establishment or extension of a national monu-
3 ment may be undertaken only by express authorization of
4 Congress.’”.
