A BILL

To expand eligibility for special overtime pay to U.S. Border
Patrol agents classified above grade GS–12.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Border Patrol Super-
5 visors Retention Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF HIGHER RATES OF REGU-**
7 **LARLY SCHEDULED OVERTIME PAY FOR CER-**
8 **TAIN U.S. BORDER PATROL AGENTS.**

9 Section 5550(h) of title 5, United States Code, is
10 amended—

1 (1) in the subsection heading, by striking “GS–
2 12 BORDER PATROL AGENTS” and inserting “BOR-
3 DER PATROL AGENTS CLASSIFIED FROM GRADE
4 GS–12 THROUGH GS–15”; and

5 (2) in paragraph (1), by striking “a position at
6 grade GS–12” and inserting “a position from grade
7 GS–12 through GS–15”.

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
