A BILL

To amend the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 to prevent the use of funds under such Act to teach or advance concepts related to gender ideology, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Say No to Indoctrina-
5 tion Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON TEACHING GENDER IDEOLOGY.**

2 Section 8526 of the Elementary and Secondary Edu-
3 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7906) is amended—

4 (1) in paragraph (6), by striking “or”;

5 (2) by redesignating paragraph (7) as para-
6 graph (8); and

7 (3) by inserting after paragraph (6) the fol-
8 lowing:

9 “(7) to teach or advance concepts related to
10 gender ideology, as defined in section 2 of Executive
11 Order 14168 (90 Fed. Reg. 8615; relating to de-
12 fending women from gender ideology extremism and
13 restoring biological truth to the Federal govern-
14 ment); or”.

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
