## A BILL

To designate the Federal building located at 300 West Congress Street in Tucson, Arizona, as the “Raúl M. Grijalva Federal Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The Federal building located at 300 West Congress  
5 Street in Tucson, Arizona, shall be known and designated  
6 as the “Raúl M. Grijalva Federal Building”.

7 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

8 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,  
9 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal

1 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be  
2 a reference to the “Raúl M. Grijalva Federal Building”.
