A BILL

To amend the National Security Act of 1947 to provide penalties for unauthorized access to intelligence community property, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Intelligence Commu-
5 nity Property Security Act of 2025”.

1 **SEC. 2. UNAUTHORIZED ACCESS TO INTELLIGENCE COM-**
2 **MUNITY PROPERTY.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The National Security Act of
4 1947 (50 U.S.C. 3001 et seq.) is amended by adding at
5 the end the following:

6 **“SEC. 1115. UNAUTHORIZED ACCESS TO INTELLIGENCE**
7 **COMMUNITY PROPERTY.**

8 “(a) IN GENERAL.—It shall be unlawful, within the
9 jurisdiction of the United States, without authorization to
10 access any property that—

11 “(1) is under the jurisdiction of an element of
12 the intelligence community; and

13 “(2) has been clearly marked as closed or re-
14 stricted.

15 “(b) PENALTIES.—Any person who violates sub-
16 section (a) shall—

17 “(1) in the case of the first offense, be fined
18 under title 18, United States Code, imprisoned for
19 not more than 180 days, or both;

20 “(2) in the case of the second offense, be fined
21 under such title, imprisoned for not more than 3
22 years, or both; and

23 “(3) in the case of the third or subsequent of-
24 fense, be fined under such title, imprisoned for not
25 more than 10 years, or both.”.

- 1 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
2 preceding section 2 of such Act is amended by adding at
3 the end the following:

“Sec. 1115. Unauthorized access to intelligence community property.”.
