## A BILL

To reauthorize the program of first responder training.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Safe Response Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. FIRST RESPONDER TRAINING PROGRAM.**

6       Section 546 of the Public Health Service Act (42  
7 U.S.C. 290ee–1) is amended—

8               (1) in subsection (a), by striking “tribes and  
9       tribal” and inserting “Tribes and Tribal”;

10              (2) in subsections (a), (c), and (d)—

1 (A) by striking “approved or cleared” each  
2 place it appears and inserting “approved,  
3 cleared, or otherwise legally marketed”; and

4 (B) by striking “opioid” each place it ap-  
5 pears;

6 (3) in subsection (f)—

7 (A) by striking “approved or cleared” each  
8 place it appears and inserting “approved,  
9 cleared, or otherwise legally marketed”;

10 (B) in paragraph (1), by striking “opioid”;

11 (C) in paragraph (2)—

12 (i) by striking “opioid and heroin”  
13 and inserting “opioid, heroin, and other  
14 drug”; and

15 (ii) by striking “opioid overdose” and  
16 inserting “overdose”; and

17 (D) in paragraph (3), by striking “opioid  
18 and heroin”; and

19 (4) in subsection (h), by striking “\$36,000,000  
20 for each of fiscal years 2019 through 2023” and in-  
21 serting “\$57,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2026  
22 through 2030”.
