A BILL

To amend title 28, United States Code, to restore executive power to appoint United States attorneys.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Restoring Executive
5 Power To Appoint United States Attorneys Act of 2025”.

6 **SEC. 2. VACANCIES.**

7 Section 546 of title, 28, United States Code is
8 amended by striking subsections (c) and (d) and inserting
9 the following:

1 “(c) A person appointed as United States attorney
2 under this section may serve until the qualification of a
3 United States attorney for such district appointed by the
4 President under section 541 of this title.”.

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
